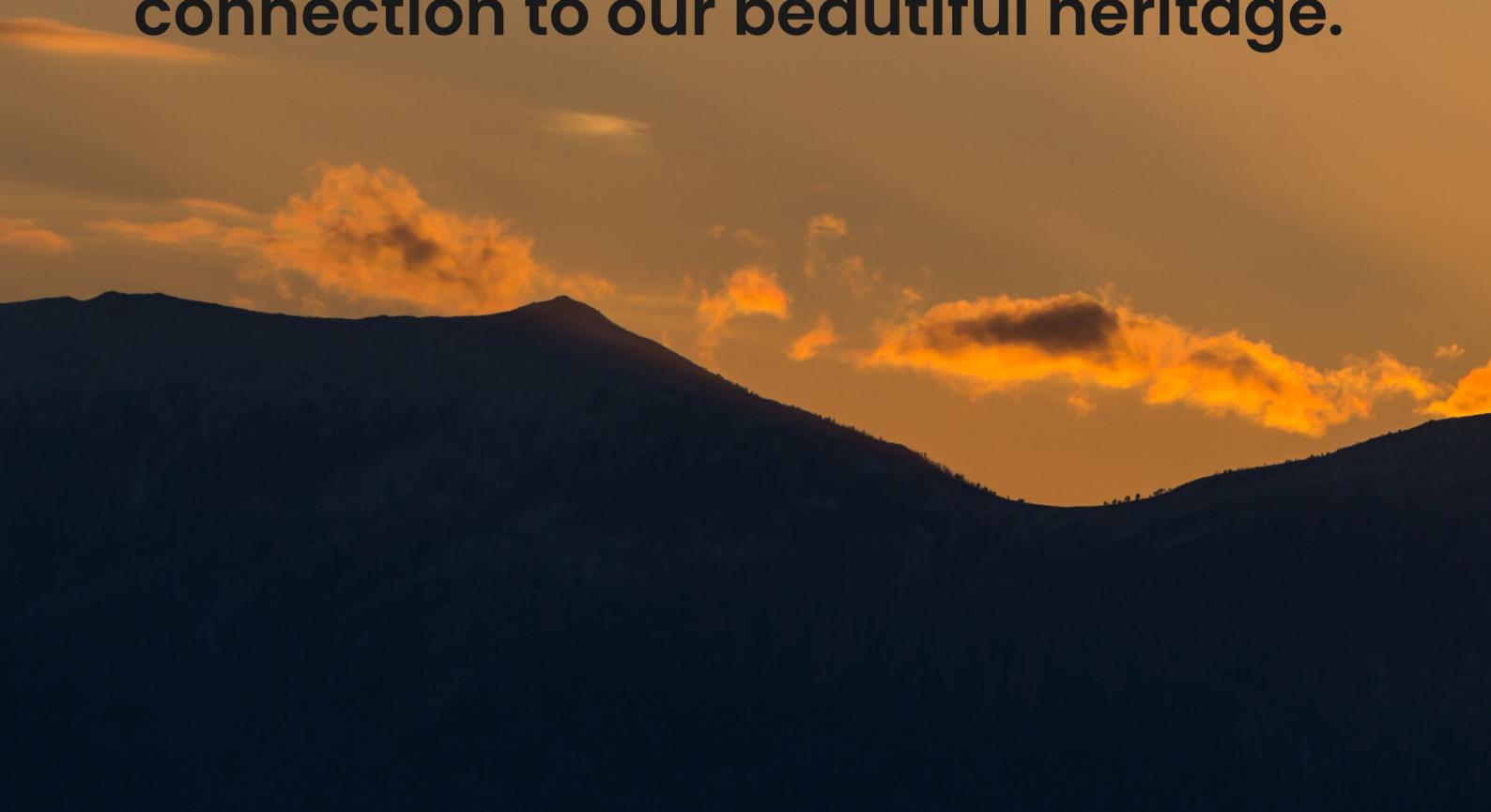

Location: 50 km from Hosur, 36 km from Dharmapuri, 2.5 hrs from Bangalore
